Call to Order

Ms. Platt called the meeting to order. Ms. Rothschild called roll to ensure a quorum was present. Mr. Williams led the Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance.

Approval of Minutes

Budget Report

Ms. Yu provided the budget report for the period ending October 31, 2021 (See Attachment A). Mr. Leak congratulated Ms. Yu and accounting staff members for a good audit report for the year ending June 30, 2021 (See Attachment B).

Director's Report

Director Unangst advised that the Board received \$119,600.00 in the initial distribution of grant money from the Appraisal Subcommittee (ASC). With the funds, the Board has hired Ms. Burnette as a full-time administrative specialist. The Board plans to also use the funds to upgrade to electronic education provider attendance reporting as well as provide staff training and travel to AARO conferences, investigative workshops, etc.

New Business

Mr. Devillier provided an overview of proposed legislation which would remove the three-year residency requirement for certified appraisers supervising trainees (See Attachment C). He asked Board members to review the verbiage and get back to him with any recommendations they may have.

Mr. Williams suggested that the experience credit log be completed by both the trainee and supervisor with the possibility of enforcing that a separate log be maintained by each appraiser.

On motion made by Mr. Russell and seconded by Mr. Leak, the Board voted unanimously to apply for continuation of the state appraiser regulatory agency support grant program and to request additional grant funds as available (See Attachment D).

There being no further business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned on motion made by Mr. Russell and seconded by Mr. Leak. Motion passed by unanimous roll call vote.
